## SENIOR MINING ENGINEER KANMANTOO COPPER PROJECT

Hillgrove Resources Limited is an Australian resources company listed on the Australian Securities Exchange (ASX: HGO) focused on finding new opportunities and developing its South Australian, Queensland and Indonesian base and precious metals projects.

Hillgrove's Flagship asset is the Kanmantoo Copper Project in the Adelaide Hills, located less than 60km from Adelaide. Development of the mine and 2Mtpa process plant is planned to commence this year. The project contains the old Kanmantoo Copper Mine pit, which was in operation from 1970 until 1976, but work by Hillgrove since 2004 has proved up an additional Indicated and Inferred Mineral Resource of 32.2Mt grading 0.9% copper (292,200 tonnes metal) and 0.2g/t gold (191,100 ounces).

Challenges which will be faced include fast ramp-up of mining operations, the requirement for superior drill and blast performance, involvement in the construction of a highly complex TSF and overall interaction between mining and process plant construction activities.

As Senior Mining Engineer at Kanmantoo you will be suited to a high level of autonomy and be able to demonstrate the ability to think constructively and quickly particularly in the start-up phase of the mining project.

Specifically the role encompasses:

- Set-up of all systems associated with mining including safety, scheduling and reporting;
- Development of final pit and dump plans;
- Proactive interaction with Geology, Metallurgy and Survey to ensure the most cost effective end result, maximising delivered ore tonnes and grade and minimising ore loss;
- Assisting with the management of the mining contractor on a day to day basis particularly with regard to the implementation of plans and schedules;
- Liaising between contractors and client staff to ensure safety and mining standards are adhered to and maintained;
- Create and implement schedules, mine plans and designs;
- Alternate cover for the Mining Manager where necessary;
- Preparation of "bottom up" mining budgets and forecasts;
- Carry out pit optimisation and feasibility studies for future developments and projects; and
- Mentoring of junior engineers.

Qualifications required are:

- Mining degree qualified with substantial metalliferous open pit experience.
- Experience with Gemcom's suite of software will be highly regarded, as will a relevant postgraduate degree.
