


## Hillgrove will be undertaking a routine, mineral exploration helicopter survey over its Exploration License (EL4401) from late April to early May 2015.

The geophysical survey system is a high frequency electromagnetic sensing technique designed to help identify geological areas that have prospectivity for minerals in an effort to extend the targeted mine life of the Kanmantoo Copper Mine.

The helicopter will fly at low altitude over crop and grazing lands, and although considered routine and safe in mineral exploration, there may be a short inconvenience to usual pastoral activities. The noise could cause sensitive stock to disperse, so it may be prudent to stable horses on the day the survey takes place over your property. Consequently, on our website we will provide survey area maps of the pastoral blocks affected by the survey and further details, so landowners can determine when the helicopter will be in their area.

The helicopter will fly an area of 105 square kilometres in a belt running south to north, from Woodchester to Mount Torrens. The survey largely surrounds, but avoids the township of Kanmantoo, with all other townships avoided. It will also avoid residences and people to comply with FAA and CASA safety requirements.

The overflying of your property will take place periodically over the course of an hour or two, as the aircraft flies along pre-determined survey lines between 100m and 200m apart in an east-west direction. The duration is determined by the size of a property, so smaller properties may only be affected for a matter of minutes.
