**Compliance Monitoring Inspection – Kanmantoo Copper Mine Expansion –  
EPBC 2013/6965**

I write in relation to the compliance monitoring inspection for the Kanmantoo Copper Mine Expansion (EPBC 2013/6965), undertaken by an Authorised Officer of the Department on 18 May 2017.

The inspection scope was to review compliance with approval conditions for the Kanmantoo Copper Mine Expansion and associated infrastructure under the EPBC approval 2013/6965.

During the inspection, the officer did not identify any non-compliance with approval conditions but did observe that one of the offsite offset areas had not yet commenced management actions. Please ensure that these offset areas are managed in accordance with the approval conditions.
